Mourning the Loss of Pope Francis

As we learned early Monday morning of the Pope's passing, there was a certain beauty in its timing. God has a way with timing. As the Easter Octave began — celebrating the glorious resurrection of our Lord in which he opened the gates of heaven — the end of the earthly life of Pope Francis reminded us of the hope of his heavenly inheritance.

Certainly, as with any death, there is a certain sadness. Pope Francis was a loving shepherd for our Church and helped navigate well in difficult times. I especially think of his wonderful homily at the onset of Covid. I was in the pope's presence four times during his pontificate (a few feet away, but never one-on-one) and can attest to his warmth, compassion, and fatherly nature. Watching him embrace infants in St. Peter's Square the first time I saw him brought a real sense of his tender care, while hearing him preach to the young people in Poland for World Youth Day showed me how evangelistic and inspiring he was.

The days of mourning, the Novemdiales do not officially begin until the papal funeral and thus will encompass April 26 through May 4. Both the 8:30 a.m. Mass at Blessed Sacrament and 5:30 p.m. at St. Alphonsus will be a Mass of the Dead for Pope Francis. Please pray for the repose his soul — customarily the Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be are encouraged. I also ask that you pray a rosary for him.

I also want to encourage prayers for the Conclave, which should begin sometime in the next few weeks (most likely early May). Let us pray the Holy Spirit is abundantly clear in this time of discernment.




