### Go Make Disciples

Over the past weeks, we have focused on encounters with Jesus. These encounters are to lead to discipleship. Now that we have clarity on this first step of encounter, what does discipleship look like?

First, let me suggest we pay careful attention to Scriptures, especially the four Gospels and Acts of the Apostles as they are read in Mass. If we relate our own selves to the disciples and first apostles, we will see how they grew in discipleship. We will be able to relate to their moments of weakness as well as celebrate the moments of epiphany, joy, and growing in understanding.

Aside from this, the journey of discipleship is marked by trust and surrender. The whole journey of faith is one of ever-growing trust in God as we surrender more and more to him. As we do this, we do what the first disciples did: we share our experiences. Foremost, I must be willing to share about my encounter with Jesus and speak to how this has altered my life. Testimony is the first and most powerful way we can evangelize.

Let me reiterate that evangelization is not optional for any Catholic. It is, in fact, the first way I follow the command of Jesus to "love one another." If I do not evangelize, then anything else I do in the name of Jesus or in the context of faith, does not give people Jesus but gives myself instead. The goal of faith is not a gift of myself. It is to give the gift of God's grace by proclaiming the gospel message of our salvation and redemption through Jesus Christ.

Likewise, fear is common, but that does not mean we can avoid evangelizing. Remember, Jesus tells his disciples to "go" and "make" disciples of all nations at the end of Matthew's gospel. This is called the Great Commission and it is the primary mission of every believer. Thankfully, he promised us the Holy Spirit, who gives us the words we need as well as his gifts of courage, wisdom, and understanding (among others) to aid us in his grace as we carry this out.

Having reflected upon all of this, I invite you to consider a day away to pray and retreat or finding a retreat opportunity in the near future in which you can encounter Jesus. In the meantime, take to prayer the following questions, reflecting upon them (perhaps even journaling about them):

Have I encountered Jesus personally? If so, when and how and what impact did those encounters have in those moments and to my how I live today? If not, take a moment to prayerfully accept Jesus into your heart right now. How can I grow in deeper trust in God? Am I a disciple? How would I rank my level of discipleship? What can I do to grow in discipleship? What fears prevent me from evangelizing? Who might the Lord be calling me to share my faith with?


