A number of parishioners have made inquiries about doing something in memory of Sister Doris who was a member of our pastoral staff for almost 25 years. She touched many lives through her ministry at Epiphany. End of Year Statements

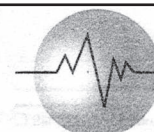

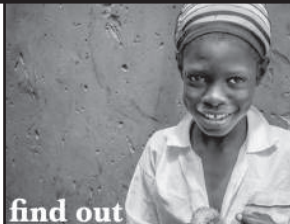
