Archdiocesan Day of Reconciliation

Pilgrimage of New York 2015 Honoring St. Joseph

From the top of Manhattan to the bottom, we will be walking the length of Manhattan visiting churches named after or in honor of Saint Joseph, the Patron of the Universal Church, making stops at the Church of Saint Joseph of the Holy Family (Harlem), Saint Joseph (Yorkville), Church of the Holy Family (United Nations) and Saint Joseph (Lower East Side). The walk is a total of 13.5 miles. The date is Saturday, March 21, 2015 (rain date is Saturday, September 26, 2015.) The pilgrimage begins at 9:00 am with opening prayers at the Shrine of St. Frances Xavier Cabrini located at 701 Fort Washington Ave. in Washington Heights and will conclude with a Pilgrims' Mass at 5:30 pm at the Shrine of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, 7 State Street, across from the Staten Island ferry. The Cardinal's Annual Appeal **2015**

We are happy to report that we have reached the half way mark for this year's Cardinal's Appeal. To date, 120 families and individuals have contributed \$68,985 toward our goal of \$134,000 or 52% of our goal. This represents a 6% participation rate of those members of the parish who received a letter from Cardinal Dolan asking for their help.

At the time this bulletin goes to press we do not know how successful our "In Pew" Sunday was last weekend. We hope that it will raise our level of contribution and participation significantly. We will have those figures in a few weeks.

We are most grateful to the 120 families and individuals who have made their gift thus far. To reach 52% of our goal with only a 6% participation rate is a tribute to their generosity. We continue to reach out to those who have not yet made a pledge to the 2015 Appeal. It is not too late. Pledge envelopes are available in the church narthex. During these last weeks of Lent, as a way of entering into the Lenten practice of almsgiving, we ask that you give prayerful consideration as to how you can help Epiphany reach our goal this year. No gift is too small as long as it comes from the heart. If it were not for the Cardinal's Appeal, many of the services that people in the Archdiocese depend upon would no longer be available. Your gift will indeed touch the life of someone in need.

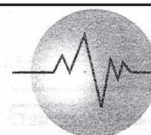
