Archdiocesan Day of Reconciliation

All parishes in the Archdiocese of New York (along with the dioceses of Brooklyn and Rockville Center) will offer the Sacrament of Reconciliation on **Monday, March 30th from 3:00 –8:00 pm**. We will have a Penance Service followed by the opportunity for individual confession beginning at 7:00 pm. This is a wonderful opportunity to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation in preparation for Holy Week and Easter.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation

The Sacrament of Reconciliation will be available on Monday, March 30th, from 3:00 pm until 8:00 pm; on Tuesday, March 31st following the 8:00 am Mass; on Wednesday, April 1st from 1 - 2 pm ; on Good Friday from 10:00 - 11:00 am; and on Holy Saturday from 1:00 - 2:00 pm. We hope that you will take advantage of one of these times to go to confession in preparation for the celebration of Easter.

The 22 Club

The 22 Club will *not* meet on March 31st during Holy Week. The next meeting will be on Tuesday, April 7th which will be an Easter Celebration.

Collection for the Holy Land

The annual collection for the support of the sacred places in the Holy Land will be taken up at the 3:00 pm Good Friday Liturgy. The large decrease in pilgrimages to the Holy Land because of the unsettled political conditions has made the upkeep of these holy places even more difficult. Please be as generous as possible.

Good Friday Way of the Cross

On Good Friday, Communion and Liberation will sponsor the *Way of the Cross Over the Brooklyn Bridge*. Participants will congregate for the first station at the Cathedral of St. James in Brooklyn at 10:00 am. After a station at the Brooklyn Bridge, the procession will follow across the bridge to a third station at City Hall Park in Manhattan and a fourth station near Ground Zero. The final station will be at St. Peter's Church on Barclay Street, concluding at 1:30 pm. At each station, there will be readings from the Passion, a meditation, reflection, and hymns. The Cardinal's Annual Appeal **2015**

We are making sure and steady progress toward reaching our parish goal of \$134,000 for the Cardinal's Appeal. Our latest update shows that 166 families and individuals have contributed \$89,850 which represents 67% of our goal. We are doing better than the Archdiocese as a whole as the Appeal is at 53% of its total goal of \$20 million. The 166 gifts we have received represents a 9% participation rate for the parish.

Although we are doing well at this point, we still have some work ahead of us to reach our goal, which we consistently have done over the years.

The key to success this year will be to increase the number of people in the parish who contribute to the Appeal. We are doing so well thus far because a number of parishioners have been extraordinarily generous. Our largest gift has been \$7,000 along with a \$5,000 gift and a number of gifts at the \$1,000 level. Not everyone has the means to be this generous, *but all of us are able to give something. Every contribution counts and many small gifts add up.*

We have approximately \$45,000 to go in order to reach our goal. We will get there if the more than 1,900 parishioners who received letters from Cardinal Dolan give something. Contribution envelopes are available in the church narthex. You can place your gift to the Appeal in the basket on Sunday.

Thank you very much to those who have brought us to 67% of our goal. And thank you also to those who will be making their gift over the coming weeks.

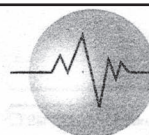
