A Message from the Pastor

I am happy to welcome as my successor as pastor of Epiphany parish Father Austin Titus, who as of August 1, 2015 will become the twelfth pastor of this community of faith that dates back to 1868 when Archbishop Michael Corrigan founded Epiphany and named the Rev. Doctor Richard L. Burtzell as its first pastor. Father Titus comes to us from Holy Family parish on Staten Island where he has been the pastor for the last twelve years. He was ordained a priest in 1992. Archdiocesan policy allows for a pastor to remain in a parish for no longer than twelve years, hence Father's assignment to Epiphany.

I have spoken to Father Titus since his appointment and he has already been here once to visit. He is very much looking forward to being pastor and told me that he has heard many good things already about Epiphany. I know that you will welcome him and make him feel at home here just as you did for me six years ago.

I would also like to take this opportunity to express my sincere thanks to two members of our staff who are leaving. Our Director of Religious Education, Mrs. Carmen DeSimone, has decided to retire. I have worked closely with her my entire time as pastor and I am grateful for her commitment to our Religious Education Program and the sacramental preparation of our children. She has done a superb job and will be missed. I wish her, as I know you do, many happy years of retirement.

I also am extremely grateful to Mr. Leo Gonzalez who has been our director of maintenance for the last five years. We have all benefited from the love and care he put into his work, making sure our church was a well kept and prayerful environment in which to pray and worship. It will not be easy to find as good a person and employee as Leo.

During July I will spend most of my time preparing for a smooth transition of pastoral leadership and getting ready to move. I will be in residence at Our Lady of the Rosary Church at 7 State Street in lower Manhattan. This is also the Mother Seton Shrine. The church is built on the site of the house that Mother Seton lived in. The Parish House is located in what is also known as the Watson House which was built in 1793. It is the last remaining federal style house in Manhattan. It is a New York City landmark and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

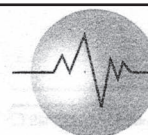
