### The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

This Sacrament is administered to bring spiritual and even physical strength during an illness, especially near the time of death. Sacraments are outward signs established by Jesus Christ to confer inward grace. The Anointing is a rite performed to bestow God's grace on the recipient through the power of the Holy Spirit.

The special grace of the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

- unites the sick person to the passion of Christ
- brings strength, peace, and courage to endure in a Christian manner the sufferings of illness or old age
- bestows the forgiveness of sins if the sick person was not able to obtain it through the sacrament of penance
- the salvation of his soul
- prepares the faithful for passing over to eternal life

We do not have to be at the point of death to receive this sacrament.

The *Catechism* says that the anointing of the sick is not a sacrament only for those who are at the point of death. As soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, it is certainly a fitting time for a Catholic to receive this sacrament.

Any parishioner in need of anointing is invited to call the rectory to make arrangements.

# **Annual Financial Report to the Parish**

FOR THE YEAR ENDED AUGUST 31, 2016

### My Fellow Parishioners:

I am pleased to report on the Church's finances. It is a solemn obligation of mine; I am accountable to you. If you have any questions or concerns about our finances, please do not hesitate to ask me or any member of the Finance Committee, who so ably advises me on our finances.

With your help, we were able to more than make up for last year's deficit. Collections <u>increased</u> 8% (\$55,097). For that, all the credit goes to you. Bequests have always been important to Epiphany, and have increased 28%. I hope that you too will include Epiphany in your Will so that Epiphany will continue to thrive.

Expenses <u>declined</u> 33% (\$337,345). Some of that is because we have postponed major infrastructure maintenance. We can accomplish that in due course, but it need not be right now. I am grateful to you and my predecessors for taking such good care of the parish over the last 149 years.

I am glad that working together we were able to accomplish these financial results. I will continue to need your help every step of the way, financial -<u>and even more</u> <u>importantly - spiritual.</u> Please know how grateful I am for your extraordinary cooperation, patience, and teamwork!


