ON THE MONEY

I am extremely grateful to all of you who contribute the best of your time, talent and treasure to Epiphany. Without you, there would be no parish. It is my solemn duty to safeguard the financial resources of the parish and to report regularly to you on our financial health. On the following page in this bulletin is a report on our Operating Results for the recently completed fiscal year ended August 31.

Collections are the key indicator of our financial health. Over the last 2 years, our collections have increased 17.8%, for which I am extremely grateful to you. Yet, we would still be in a precarious position if it were not for other sources of income (for example, bequests), which this year accounted for 74% of our surplus. It would be foolish to rely on these other sources of income, because they are uncertain and unpredictable. (What is certain, of course, is death, and I hope every parishioner - including myself - will provide for Epiphany in his/her Will.)

Many thanks to our Finance Committee (John Murphy, Andrea Heidbreder, Lauren Massey, Rob Kelly, Bart Codd, Jim Hayes, and Kate McHugh) for their unrelenting support and advice. If you have any concerns or questions, please see me or any of the Committee members.
