#### Abortion Expansion in the NYS 2018 budget

The proposed 2018 NYS budget includes a proposal to do away with many limits on abortion.

- expand the time period for legal abortions beyond the current 24-week limit. (Studies show that unborn babies are able to experience pain at 20 weeks.)
- eliminate the law that requires adequate health care to babies born alive after a late-term abortion procedure (5-10% of abortion attempts produce a born-alive infant).
- permit non-doctors to perform abortions. NYS could grant a license to perform abortions to anyone it sees fit.
- eliminate all criminal penalties for abortions. (ex: against a mother's will, or if a deliberate violent attack causes the death of an unborn baby.)
