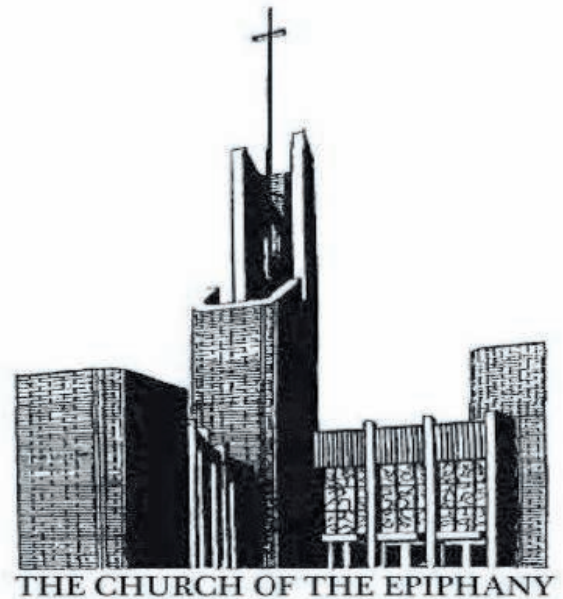

After 12 months without donations, non-donors are deleted from the system to avoid the expense involved in mailing, database maintenance, etc.

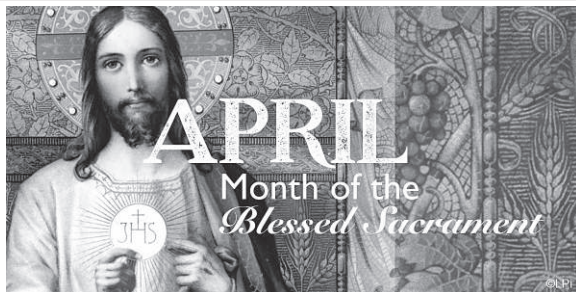
