5 MINUTE EXERCISE: HOW TO BE WITH GOD ALL DAY The Examen: Five Minutes, Five Easy Steps

Our Epiphany family is busy! And sometimes we don't realize how God is walking with us throughout every moment of our day. St. Ignatius Loyola's Examen is a great way to stop for five minutes -- once, or multiple times during our day -- to find the movement of God in the events of our day. The Examen is simply a set of introspective prompts for you to follow or adapt to your own character and spirit.

 Begin with a pause and a slow, deep breath or two; become aware that you are in the presence of the Holy. Pray for God's help.

2. Give Thanks

What am I especially grateful for in the past day . . . The gift of another day...

The love and support I have received...

The courage I have mustered...

An event that took place today...


Someone (friend or stranger) whose presence blessed me...

3. Review my day so far. I ask for the light to know God and to know myself as God sees me.

Where have I felt true joy today? What has troubled me today? What has challenged me today? Where and when did I pause today? Have I noticed God's presence in any of this?

- 4. Respond to God's graces for me today In each of the graced moments that I have been given so far today, how have I responded? With gratitude? With joy? Did I even notice them? Did I behave negatively?
- 5. As I look ahead at the rest of the day or tomorrow How shall I live differently? Is God calling me to do something, change something in my life, say yes to someone, apologize to someone I may have hurt?

Allow God to speak to you throughout the 5-minute Examen, and then...resume your life!!
