THE BREAD WHICH HOSTS LIFE



On the evening after Passover God told the Hebrew people exiting Egypt not to allow their bread to rise with leaven, but to grab everything and leave. As Moses led his

starving people in the desert, God rained down manna - a fine, frost-like food - upon them., which they ground and pounded into cakes, baking them with oil.

Every Passover afterwards, the Jews would not eat leavened bread. They believed that explain that leavened bread represented ego and self-aggrandizement, while unleavened bread represented humility.





Jesus ate a meal of unleavened bread and wine at the Last Supper with his disciples, the origin of our Eucharist.



After Jesus had departed, the Apostles remembered and experienced His presence in a ritual meal of bread and wine in one another's homes. Eventually a liturgy of the Word was developed, and by the year 150 AD the basic structure of the Mass as we know it was in place. It continued to be celebrated in private homes until around 313AD. The earliest image of the round form and shape of the host was found in catacombs in the same century.







In the Roman Catholic Church, bread for the Eucharist must be made of wheat, be unleavened, and be recently made and unspoiled.
