



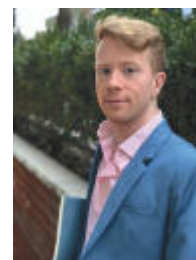

The mission of the Church

comes from Matthew's Gospel, in the Great Commission" (28:19-20) The wavering disciples were told:

Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you."

The Greek word for "disciple" is *mathetes*, which means "to learn". To be a disciple is to be a *learner*.

To be a disciple of Jesus Christ is to be engaged in a lifelong process of learning from and about the Jesus, the master, Jesus the teacher.

To be a disciple is to commit to such a process of growth.

To learn from Jesus is to walk with Jesus.



"The difficult truth for us in the church is that so many of our people have never come to know Jesus personally, and therefore have **no hunger for him**. We still have the shadow of duty and fear as a religious motivation hanging over us. Scripture tells us, however, that where this is active, perfect love has not been discovered. (1John 4:18). It is often not a *willful* reduction of faith to simple *knowledge about* Jesus, but a lack of awareness that it is even possible to know him and to be loved personally by him.

We are often like people who live in a black-and-white world who cannot begin to conceive of the reality of **color**. The fact that so many Catholics are utterly convinced that they are missing nothing shows that the weekly experience of faith and "religion" act as a kind of vaccine to the full power of the Christian faith."

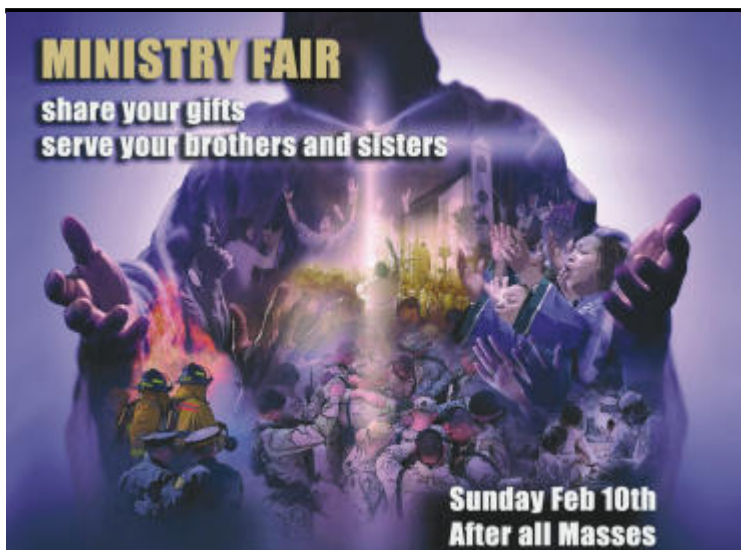
