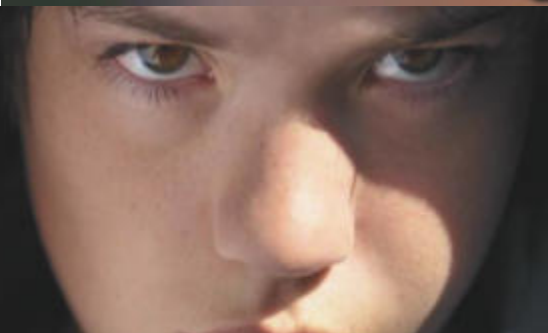

Catholics in good health ages 18 to 59 are  
required to fast and to abstain from meat  
on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Fasting consists of eating only one meal,  
with the possibility of two smaller snacks  
that do not add up to a single full meal.

Catholics age 14 and older are to abstain  
from meat on all Fridays in Lent.

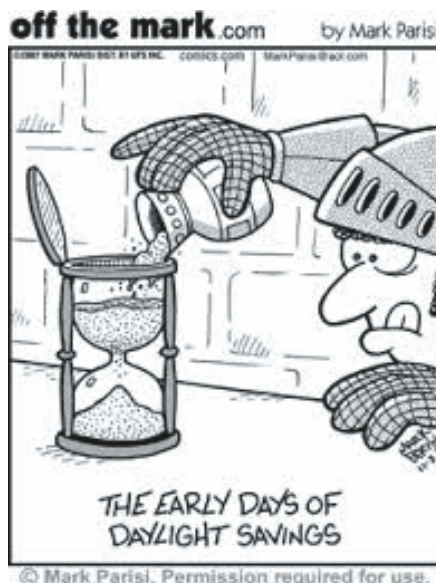

## It began with a a bright, earnest young man

who was precociously eager to make a difference in his world. He joined the Scouts, drawn to their oath and promise of duty to God, country, other people, and self. And from the beginning, he had his eyes on the prize: to become an Eagle Scout, the highest achievable rank in the organization. Eagle Scouts are expected to set an example for other Scouts and to become the leaders in life that they have demonstrated themselves to be in the Boy Scouts. They are disproportionately represented in the military, service academy graduates, in higher education and academia, major professions, the clergy, business and politics ,

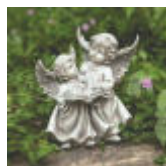

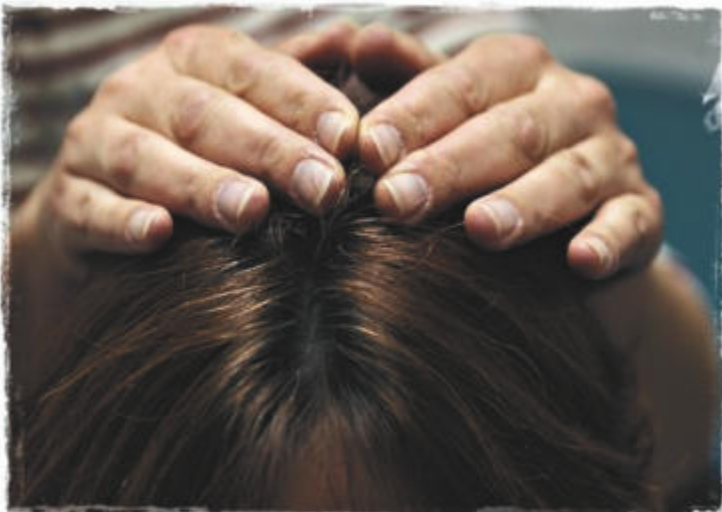

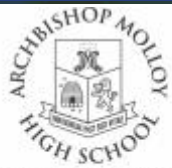
