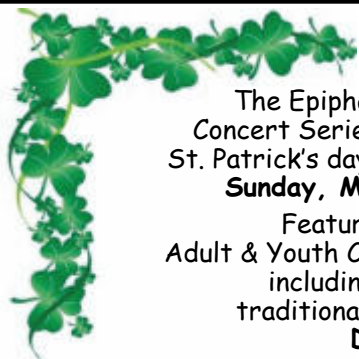

A very important message about SCAMS!!!

Recently, phone & e-mail scammers have been 'phishing' for
targets among the good people of our parish.

Follow a few cautionary steps to avoid
falling victim to the evil people who take
advantage of the innocent.



- 1) **Never give your personal info** to a person who has contacted you 'out of the blue'. Scammers pretend to be gov't officials (ex: IRS), family members, charities.
- 2) **Don't believe your caller ID**. Scammers can fake a caller ID with a number similar to yours.
- 3) **Never pay in advance** for a promise, i.e., debt relief, prize money.
- 4) **Never purchase gift cards or wire money** as a form of payment. Gov't offices and legitimate companies will **NEVER** require these methods of payment.
- 5) **DON'T BE RUSHED!** Scammers will force you to act quickly.
TALK TO SOMEONE YOU TRUST!! Before you give up money or information, run it by a friend or family member.
- 6) **Never allow remote access** to your computer to anyone you do not know **PERSONALLY**.

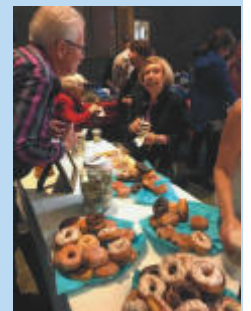
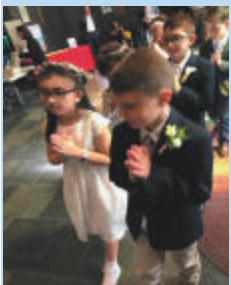
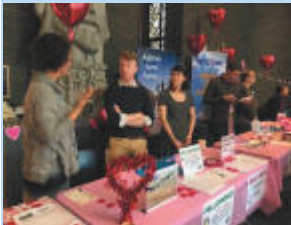
