





We watched the whole thing.

We sat on the dirt, I sat inside my mama's legs, her arms wrapped around my chest, and we both just cried until there were no more tears left. Blood was coming out of his pores, he was trying to breathe, I think he was suffocating. His face got all red, then violet, then gray, and his chest was all distorted-looking. I tried to breathe for him, I kept taking deep breaths when it looked like he couldn't do it, and I thought I was suffocating too.

I looked at his arms draped across the wood, and his veins were practically popping out of them, and even though they were filthy and bloody and had some bruises on them, I thought they were the most beautiful arms I had ever seen in my life, I loved his outstretched arms, and looked at them and looked at them and looked at them, and my eyes filled with new tears because I remembered that those arms had pulled me out of the well and had held me close as I sat on his lap and we laughed together.

And through my teary eyes I saw his arms suddenly grow limp, and in that instant the sky got black as night and a huge thunderclap came out of the sky and I thought it hit us and we were all dead. But we weren't dead, he was, and his body was limp on the wood.

remember: God's

turn away from the
child He loves, even
one who abandons
Him.

He offers, instead, forgiveness. Grace. Reconciliation. A chance to come back. You know what? There is no better time than now to celebrate the sacrament of reconciliation, to restore what was broken, to heal what was hurt.

THE EASTER TRIDUUM

The Easter Triduum (three days) begins during Holy Week, and is made up of the holidays Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday, and Easter Sunday. This includes the Easter Vigil, the focal point of the Triduum. The Triduum celebrates the heart of Christian faith, salvation, and redemption: the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Thus, the Triduum commemorates the Institution of the Eucharist; the passion, crucifixion, death of the Lord; his descent to the dead; and finally his glorious resurrection on Easter Sunday.

On Holy Thursday, the Triduum begins for Catholics with the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper, during which bells are rung and the organ played. The bells and organ will then remain silent until the Easter Vigil Mass. The Mass of the Lord's Last Supper includes a ritual washing of feet in most Catholic congregations. The altars are stripped of ornamentation, leaving only the cross and candlesticks.

The Good Friday church ceremony marks the Crucifixion of Jesus Christ. The liturgy of the Lord's Passion consists of three parts: the liturgy of the Word, the veneration of the Cross, and the reception of Communion. Although Communion is given and received, this liturgy is not a Mass; this practice dates back to the earliest years of the Church and is meant to emphasize the somber, mournful character of the day. The Body of Christ that is received by the faithful on Good Friday was consecrated the prior evening at the Mass of the Lord's Supper and, in most cases, was adored until midnight or another late hour.

The Faster Vicil is "the mother of all vigils". Being a vigil — a time of anticipation and preparation — it takes place at night, starting after nightfall and finishing before daybreak on Easter, thus beginning and ending in darkness. It consists of four general parts: the Service of Light, the Liturgy of the Word, Christian Initiation, and Liturgy of the Eucharist. It is the most important liturgy in the whole church year.
