- No "credibly accused" priest is currently in ministry.
- The largest share of "credibly accused" priests were ordained over 60 years ago.
- No priest ordained in the last 20 years has been "credibly accused".
- Most of the abuse occurred 30 to 50 years ago.

"Credibly accused" includes victims who were unable to identify the accused priest.

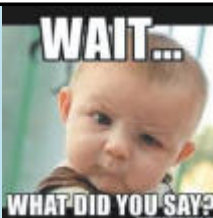

With your shawl in hand, the person who prays is not alone. There is strength in knowing that your love & prayers are crocheted into every little loop.

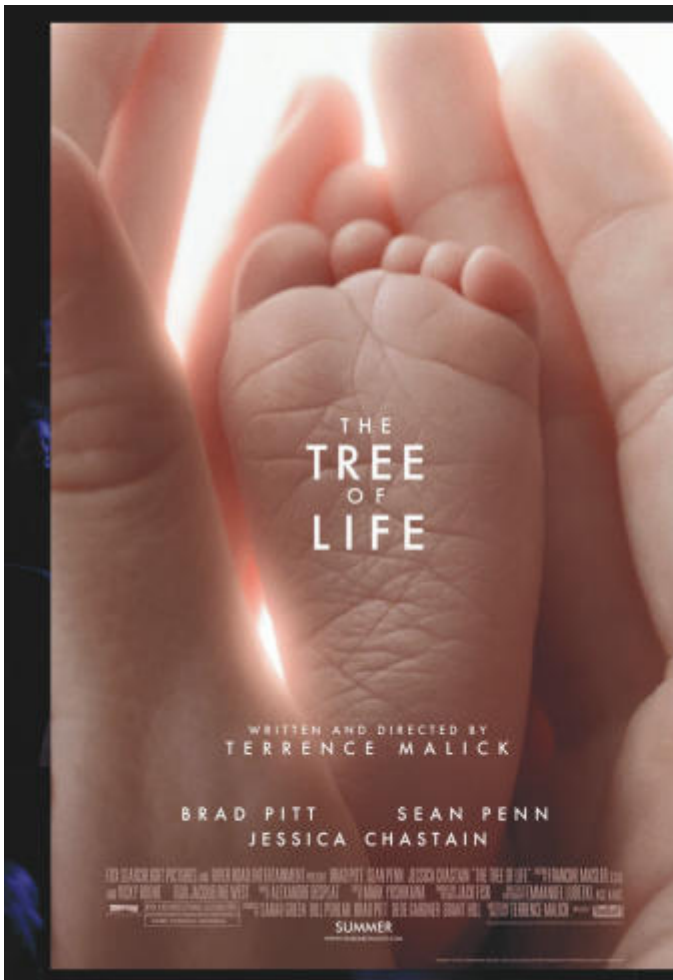
