- The largest share of "credibly accused" priests were ordained over 60 years ago.
- No priest ordained in the last 20 years has been "credibly accused".
- Most of the abuse occurred 30 to 50 years ago.

"Credibly accused" includes victims who were unable to identify the accused priest.

Join our ministry to bring comfort & hope to the sick & dying by crocheting a sweet (3"x4") pocket prayer shawl.






