- No "credibly accused" priest is currently in ministry.
- The largest share of "credibly accused" priests were ordained over 60 years ago.
- No priest ordained in the last 20 years has been "credibly accused".
- Most of the abuse occurred 30 to 50 years ago.

"Credibly accused" includes victims who were unable to identify the accused priest.

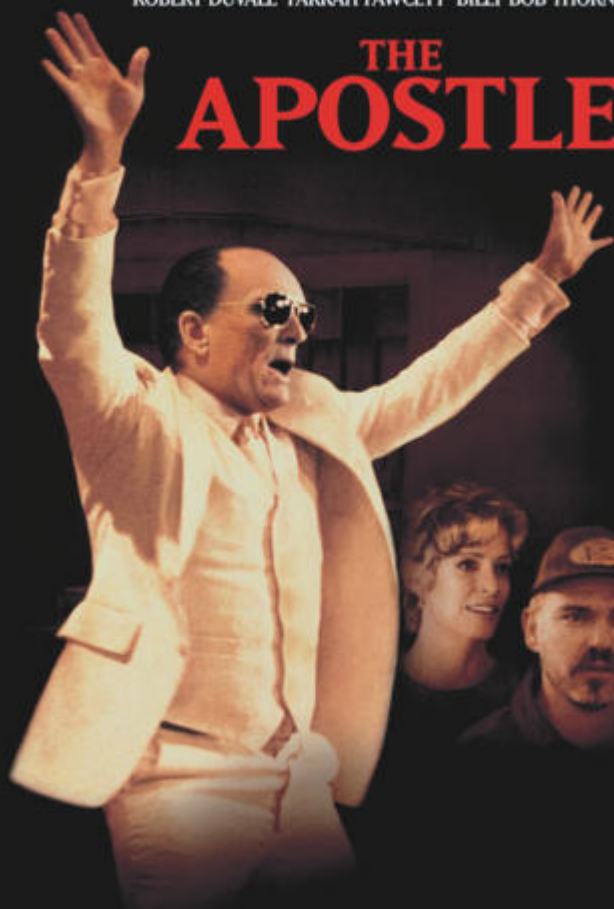

SUMMER FILMMAKING FOR TEENS

INFORMATION ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Summer Filmmaking program for teens is designed to provide Epiphany Church teenagers with the opportunity to learn all aspects of filmmaking by participating in the production of a Christmas-themed narrative short film for Epiphany parish. Teen participants will learn the power of film to speak truthfully about life in all its joys and sorrows, always with the understanding of God's creative presence beneath the process of each phase of filmmaking.

No previous experience is necessary, but commitment to the process is required! We are looking for a relatively small group of Epiphany teens who will bond with one another in the common goal of making something beautiful for others to experience. Beyond learning about film, it is hoped that the program will offer a community experience for teenagers who have not previously had such an opportunity at our church. Students from 8th grade to 12th grade will be considered.



Classes will teach all three phases of making a film: Preproduction, Production and Postproduction. Students will learn how to **conceive of a film idea**, and **write a script**. Filmmaking is



storytelling with moving pictures, and consequently there is a unique writing format for film scripts. Other lessons will introduce the basics of **producing a film**, **directing actors**, learning how to effectively **use cameras**, **lighting instruments**, and **audio technology**, and experiencing the 'writing' in post-production **digital editing**.

The summer schedule for the film project will be created around the participants who will be selected. It might involve weekday sessions, weeknight sessions, or weekend sessions. In all likelihood, the editing process will continue through the fall, working again within the schedules of the participants.

Fr Jim Mayzik SJ will be directing the program. He received a degree in filmmaking from NYU's Tisch School of the Arts, and founded the Film and Television academic program at Fairfield University. He also directed Fairfield's Media Center, with a staff of 15 media professionals, producing hundreds of programs for the university and other clients. Fr Mayzik has written, produced and directed several feature films, documentaries, short films and web series. In this project he will be accompanied by former students who work in the film/tv industry in New York City.

There will be a small fee of \$200 per student, to pay for production expenses of the film. (Fr Mayzik's summer filmmaking camp at Fairfield University had a fee of \$1200 for one week.)

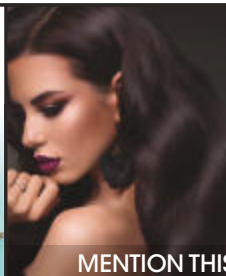

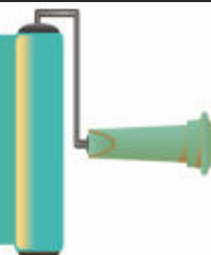
