

I Just Throw Money in the Basket"

It is one of the most common expressions we hear at the rectory. Often people come to request proof of "active membership" at Epiphany – to become a godparent, for school admission, etc. Often, we do not recognize them. When we inform them that we have no record of them as committed parishioners, they usually say, "I just throw money in the basket."

If you are a "registered" parishioner, you have chosen Epiphany as your spiritual home and you are an active contributor of your sacrificial love, time, talent, and treasure.

It does <u>NOT</u> mean that you filled out a form once, perhaps many years ago. Rather, it requires active sacrificial participation with your love, time, talent, and treasure.

In the Bible, the faithful gave the best of their harvest, the best of their herds in sacrifice to God. Even the poorest parents made a loving gift of two turtle doves when presenting their child at the temple. They were acknowledged as members of the faithful with their sacrificial offering at the temple.

God still asks that we do our best in imitation of Jesus' total selfgiving to us.

She knew her purpose in life.


