



#### Inconvenient Death

Is there ever really a convenient time for death?

daily coffee	convenient
flat tire	not convenient
dental work	not convenient
pick up milk & bread	convenient
brunch with friends	convenient
wake and funeral	not convenient

Even when death comes as a relief after a protracted illness and we believe that our loved one is "in a better place", there isn't anything quick & easy about the farewell that follows.

The notion of death "getting in the way of our life" has some strange repercussions. The "inconvenience" of a loss has caused many of us to discard the respectful etiquette that used to accompany bereavement. We've lost our way in evaluating the gravity of the moment.

We needn't return to the past when a small town would close down for the day so that everyone could follow the hearse to the cemetery and return to the church for an afternoon of casseroles & cakes.

What can we do to show reverence for a death?

For the family, we can visit at the viewing and attend the funeral. And for ourselves, we can simply slow down, even for just a few minutes, and consider the loss of someone in our community as an event worthy of reflection. "Our community" can be work associates; it can be family, friends, or neighborhood acquaintances.


When we pay our respects, we can dress appropriately. We can be on time for the services. We can stay a moment to show the family that we are not squeezing them into our crowded calendar. Take a moment to be "inconvenienced."

Alpha is a series of sessions exploring our Catholic faith.




