

What You Need To Know About Sun Safety

Skin cancer is the most common cancer in the U.S. Excessive exposure to the sun can lead to skin cancer, although this can be prevented by protecting ourselves while outdoors.

UV rays are an invisible type of radiation that comes from the sun and tanning beds. These rays can cause skin damage, as well as damage to our eyes. Summit Medical Group, in Knoxville, TN, states that even on a cloudy day, whether it is winter or summer months, about 80% of the UV rays can pass through the clouds and affect our skin and eyes. Therefore, it is extremely important to protect our skin and eyes while outdoors.

Here are a few tips for outdoor sun safety from the American Academy of Dermatology Association and Summit Medical Group:

Seek shade when available

Wear a broad-spectrum sunscreen of at least 30 SPF or higher-apply generous amounts of sunscreen.

When swimming or sweating, use a water-resistant sunscreen and apply at least every two hours.

Wear sun-protective clothing

Wear sunglasses with 100 percent UV protection, preferably wrap-around style

Wear a broad-brimmed hat, in addition to your sunglasses

Never look directly at the sun, UV rays can damage your eyes

Keep in mind that the sun's UV rays are the strongest between the hours of 10am and 4 pm. By following these suggestions for sun safety, we may be able to decrease our chances of skin cancer and damage to our eyes.
