PARISH BOOKKEEPER'S PART-TIME POSITION

This position will maintain the financial bookkeeping records of the parish in accordance with parish and diocesan guidelines and provide back-up assistance to the Administrative Assistant, as needed. This hourly position will report to the pastor and is expected to work in the office as needed to perform job duties, approximately 20 hours. Candidates should have the following qualifications: at minimum an Associate's degree in accounting or five years equivalent bookkeeping experience; good understanding of cash receipts, disbursements, payroll, general ledger, financial reporting processes and positive pay bank process; experience with Microsoft Word, Excel, Outlook and Publisher; knowledge of the Parish Data System bookkeeping system or equivalent; ability to type and perform routine mathematical computations; have communication and computer skills; willingness to undergo a background check, follow diocesan policies, and become bonded, if necessary. Candidates should also provide references demonstrating personal integrity and the ability to properly maintain confidential information. Position requires sitting and standing associated with a normal office environment, including communications via phone and email. Manual dexterity using calculator, computer keyboard is required, and ability to analyze financial data. CMG Connect Safe Haven is an online program that requires ALL employees and ALL volunteers to watch videos and answer accountability questions at the end of each segment, submit to a background check through CMG Connect initially and then re-certify in 5 years. The training can be done on a person's own schedule and no in-person training is required which is a time-saving effort by not having to wait for a VIRTUS class in your area. The CMG Connect Safe Haven videos are available in English and Spanish. Background checks are done through the CMG Connect portal with a company named Selection. Users will complete their own personal information which eliminates any paper forms and ensures the security of individual's personal information. The background check is processed after meeting all of the requirements with the curriculum and the "meets criteria or does not meet criteria" results will be ready to review from the administrator dashboard. This process ensures user's data cannot be compromised since the background check cannot be edited. Background checks will be required every 5 years. Please go to our website and scroll down on the right side, you will see CMG Connect. Click on CMG Connect and you will be able to complete your information there. You will need to complete the safe environment section and then complete the background and then submit it. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact the church office.
