Pastor's Corner Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord 1 June 2025

God mounts His throne to shouts of joy: a blare of trumpets for the Lord! My dear brothers and sisters in Christ, we must remember that Jesus Christ always remains with us through the power of the Holy Spirit – the Advocate – the Paraclete!

Jesus promised to remain with us always even until the end of the age – the end of time itself! Even though we can no longer see Him with bodily eyes, He is indeed very near to us, with us, and inside of us every time we receive Holy Communion. According to the Universal Prayer and Commentary by FAITH Catholic, “Through the Holy Spirit, [Jesus] continues to enlighten, guide, comfort, and inspire us to be like Him, bearing witness to the goodness and power of God until He comes again” [at the end of time – the Second Coming – the Parousia]. The Holy Spirit Who proceeds from both God the Father and God the Son, is the Spirit of wisdom and revelation Whom we need to truly know Jesus Christ. The Advocate – the Paraclete – will remind us of everything that the Son had taught the human race while He still walked the earth in the Flesh, in bodily form, before His Ascension. This is the very same Spirit Whom St. Paul asks God the Father to grant to the Ephesians in our second reading today.

The Apostles see Jesus being taken up above the clouds into heaven. We are told that at the Second Coming, the Parousia, the Last Judgment, Jesus will return to earth in the same way that He was taken up into heaven on Ascension Day.

We must remember that Jesus Christ never leaves us! His Spirit is always with us to lead us and to guide us towards the right path – the path of truth and righteousness! We only have to seek the Lord with all of our hearts and call upon Him in humility. We cannot make demands on God. Sometimes we want what we want, and we want it now! That is not the way to approach God, or to ask for something from Him. We must humbly turn to Him and trust in Him, and then we will surely receive what is indeed good for our well-being and our salvation in God's time! We only have to ask, and we shall receive! If we seek, we shall indeed find! **However, we must allow God to open the eyes of our hearts, and the eyes of our minds as well so that they are both enlightened with God's wisdom and His grace.** (Ephesians 1:17-23) [2]

Our Gospel passage from St. Luke states: “Then [Jesus] opened their minds to understand the [Sacred Scriptures], and said to them, ‘Thus it is written, that the Christ should suffer and on the third day rise from the dead, and that repentance and forgiveness of sins should be preached in His name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things. And behold, I send the promise of My Father upon you.’ ... Then He led them out as far as Bethany, and lifting up His hands, He blessed them. While He blessed them, He parted from them and was carried up into heaven. And they worshiped Him, and returned to Jerusalem with great joy, and were continually in the temple blessing God.” [3] (Luke 24:45-53)

“On this Solemnity of the Ascension, we recall with praise what Jesus has done for us by His suffering, death, and resurrection. We are called to not simply meditate on these events, but to bring the fruits of our prayer into the world as His witnesses. **This is the task of the Church – to preach the Gospel to all nations** – and we participate in this individually by living and proclaiming our faith within our own spheres of influence.” [4]

God mounts His throne to shouts of joy: a blare of trumpets for the Lord! However, He remains with us always, until the end of time itself, in the Real Presence of the Holy Eucharist (Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity), and in His Spirit – the Holy Spirit – Whom He promised to send us so that He could lead us and guide us towards our true home – our true final resting place – heaven itself! All that we need to do is to truly believe in Him! Be well and God bless you all. Happy Easter!
