Pastor's Corner

Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

15 June 2025



"We are called to contemplate with wonder and awe the beauty of God!" [1]

The Most Holy Trinity—Undivided Unity. Three Divine Persons in One God. According to the Daily Universal Prayer and Commentary by FAITH Catholic, "The Church invites us to humbly explore the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity and to grapple with the truths of this fundamental insight into the essence of God's being. The three [Divine] Persons of the Holy Trinity – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit – are One, but are distinct from each other. Thus, we can say they are in relationship with one another – an eternal communion of love. Confronted with this mystery, let us contemplate with wonder and awe the beauty of [the Triune] God." [2]

"In the first reading [from the Book of Proverbs], the wisdom of God speaks of being present when the Lord established the heavens, *beside Him as His craftsman*. In the Epistle, Paul writes, *we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ*, and that the Holy Spirit has been given to us. In the Gospel [passage from St. John], Jesus tells His disciples that the Spirit of truth will guide them *to all truth*, declaring to them everything that is His." [3]

According to Rev. Peter Tynan, OSB, "Today's gospel tells of a tender moment between Jesus and His disciples. Jesus and the disciples know that things are tense for them in Jerusalem. The authorities want to put an end to Jesus' work, most likely in a violent manner. This causes a shadow of worry to hang over them—over the disciples, for there is so much more to learn, so much they still don't understand. They want their relationship with Jesus to continue." [4]

"Jesus acknowledges His disciples' concern when He says, 'I have much more to tell you, but you cannot bear it now.' He wants the relationship to continue as well, not only because He has grown close to them over the years they have walked together, but because of who He is. Jesus is the Second Person of the Trinity. He is God, and God is love. Love is being in a relationship, or it is nothing at all." [5]

"The reason for this is that God is a unity of three Persons and not a society of three individuals. A person only exists when in a relationship with others. The Person of God the Father is not independent from the Son or the Holy Spirit but is necessarily in relationship with them. They are equally one in existence. An individual, in contrast, seeks his or her own freedom. Relationships can only be for their individual benefit. ...The Trinity could not exist if it were composed of individuals. The three individuals would be in conflict with one another over whose freedom comes first." [6]

"Jesus, being who He is—a Person of the Holy Trinity—will never abandon His beloved apostles. So, He promises them that something of Himself will remain with them and all who follow them. Jesus gives his fellow Person of the Trinity: The Holy Spirit. 'When He comes the Spirit of truth,' Jesus promises, 'He will guide you to all truth.' This gift of the Holy Spirit will make Jesus present in a mystical way. His presence and His work will continue on." [7]

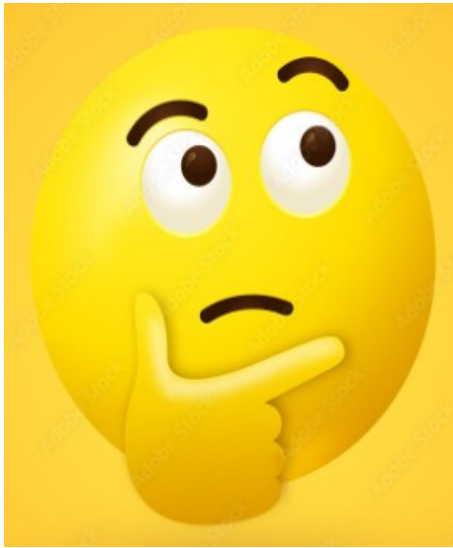

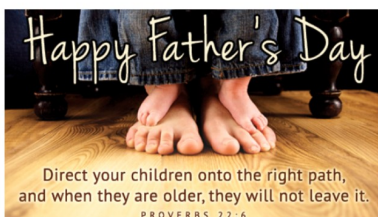
