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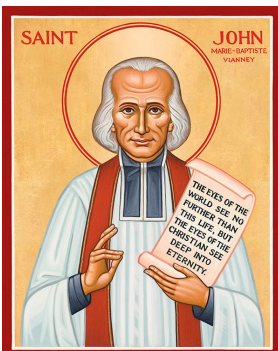
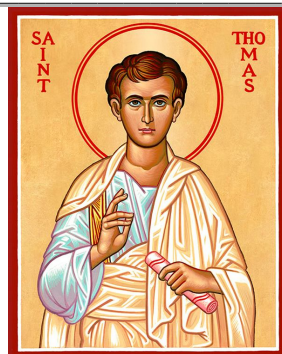

Pastor's Corner

Twenty-Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

21 September 2025

Trustworthiness – Good stewardship when it comes to the proper use of the gifts that God has given to each of us (*time, talent and treasure*). **Justice** – **Even-handedness when it comes to the just treatment of *everyone* without exception!** This is what true Christians, true Disciples of Christ, are called to do. Remember, we must always use our gifts to bear good fruit – an abundant harvest for the kingdom of God for one day, we will all have to render an accounting of what we produced with the time, talent and treasure with which God blessed each of us with in our life here on earth.

If we prove **trustworthy** in small matters, our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, will entrust us with larger matters for the salvation of souls – both our own, and the souls of others! Recall that Jesus Christ told a parable in the Gospel of St. Luke in which a nobleman went on a journey to a distant country to receive kingly power. Before he left, he entrusted money to ten of his servants with the expectation that each would trade with the money given to them so that more would be produced while he was away. Nine of the servants produced revenue while one did not. To the nine good stewards, the nobleman said, “Well done, good servant! Because you have been faithful in a very little, you shall have authority over [much]’...However, there was one lazy servant who did not even put the nobleman’s money into the bank to gain interest while he was away. To this servant, the nobleman said, ‘I will condemn you out of your own mouth, you wicked servant! You knew that I was a severe man, taking up what I did not lay down and reaping what I did not sow? Why then did you not put my money into the bank, and at my coming I should have collected it with interest? And he said to those who stood by, ‘Take the [money] from him, and give it to the one who has the [most money]...I tell you that to every one who has will more be given; but from him who has not, even what he has will be taken away.’” (Luke 19:17-26) [1]

As for the dishonest steward in today’s Gospel passage, true Disciples of Christ do not want to be compared with him. Why not? The people who are of this world (not of the kingdom of God) are shrewd with the things of this world, which they choose to make their home. True Disciples of Christ are learned in the things of heaven – things that are of heaven and of God – actions that are saintly, heavenly and Godly! To these will be granted entry into the kingdom of heaven – the home of God – the place where God can be seen in the fullness of His glory!

Which home shall we choose? The “home” of this world, or the “true and everlasting home” of heaven? Someday this world will pass away. Heaven will never pass away. Heaven will last forever! Beware! Will we prove to be trustworthy in small matters so that God will entrust us with larger ones? Or, on the other hand, will we have what we were entrusted with taken away because of our lack of trustworthiness, or lack of justice in dealing with others? Which will we choose?

Remember, no servant can be faithful to or serve two different masters. According to the Sacred Scriptures, “No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon.” (Matthew 6:24) [2] “For where your treasure is, there will ***your heart*** be also.” (Matthew 6:21) [3]

Trustworthiness – Good stewardship when it comes to the proper use of the gifts that God has given to each of us (*time, talent and treasure*). **Justice** – **Even-handedness when it comes to the just treatment of *everyone* without exception!** This is what true Christians, true Disciples of Christ, are called to do. **Be well and may God bless you all!**

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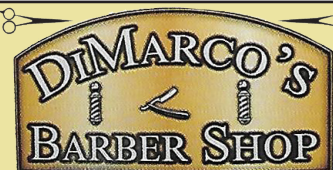


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
