

Dear Candidates for the Sacrament of Confirmation:

One of the activities that we do before receiving Confirmation is to write to the Archbishop Naumann, who will administer the Sacrament.

Writing a letter to the Archbishop is an official way to express your desire to be Confirmed. When you write your letter, make it meaningful and personal. Don't make it sound like a form letter. Your letter should be unique and unlike any other from your class. Let it sound like you! Let Archbishop Naumann know about your personal faith journey in preparing for Confirmation. The Archbishop may use these letters when composing his homily for the Confirmation Mass.

**These letters are to be completed at home and submitted to the St. Michael the Archangel website by March 8, 2023.** Neatness, proper spelling, grammar, etc. are required. **This letter must be typed.** All letters will be mailed to the Archbishop together in one envelope.
