


Our Purpose

Responding to today's teens

Life Teen put together a 2024 report on The State of Catholic Youth in America.

Here's what the numbers say:

- Only 24% of American Youth identify as Catholic
- 43% of Gen Z Catholic Youth belive in the True Presence of the Eucharist
- 1 in 3 teens claim a Christian identity but do not have a relationship with Christ
- Religious disaffiliation typically happens between the ages of 15-29



Our Purpose

Responding to today's teens

- 44% of high schoolers reported feeling persistently sad or hopeless in 2021
- Only 51% of high school students feel like they belong at their schools
- 4/5 teens say they lack purpose in life

1 CORE TEAM

We have a team of adult and high school volunteers that are on mission to make every teen feel known, heard, and loved.

3 GAMES

We are going to have fun and live in the joy that our God desires for us. Games provide shared experiences as a foundation to build authentic relationships from. 2 SMALL GROUPS

These groups will remain steady throughout the 2 years and provide a space for connections to be made and questions to be asked. No question is a bad question in small group.


Sponsor Selection and Eligibility: January 14

The life of a Christian believer is not easy. We need to have people around us to support and uplift us as we journey closer to Christ.

This is a lifelong commitment that must be taken seriously.

A sponsor's responsibility is to disciple the candidate and help them fulfill their baptismal promise and live a life of prayer, sacraments, and evangelization.

- Must be 16 years old
- Must be practicing Catholic & received Baptism, Confirmation & first Eucharist
- Only ONE sponsor



Therefore, since we have so great a cloud of witnesses surrounding us, let us also lay aside every encumbrance and the sin which so easily entangles us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us,

Patron Saint

Saint names due: January 14

In choosing a confirmation saint, we are choosing someone we want to be like and someone that can pray for us from heaven.

A saint is someone who has walked the Christian walk before us, and we can ask for their prayers just as we would a friend. They help us in our journey towards sainthood.

We also take on their name. This has biblical roots. Simon's name changed to Peter when he took on a new mission. Likewise you take on a new name as you take on a new mission in the Church.



7th Grade Retreat

This optional retreat option is offered to 7th graders. It will be hosted at St. Michael the Archangel from 10 am to 3 pm.

As modeled by Jesus, retreats are a cornerstone for our spiritual life and as we walk with your teen we want to provide a space for every teen to step away from the noise of the world and listen to the calm, still voice of the Lord.

It is a great opportunity for your teen to grow in relationship with other teens their age and our EDGE Core Team. It will include a time of games, talks, small groups, and time for prayer. Lunch will be provided.

Christian Service

Reports due: April 29

Confirmation calls us to live a life of discipleship. Part of being a disciple is living a life of service. As we do service to prepare for confirmation we will come to know Christ in a new way and come to live out a life of discipleship.

We are not asking for a specific number of hours of a certain type to fulfill but rather a self-directed service project that should be a cumulative of 10-15 hours and share your experience in a report.

This should be service that is modeled by the corporal works of mercy:

- Feed the hungry
- Give drink to the thirsty
- Shelter the homeless
- Visit the sick
- Visit the imprisoned
- Bury the dead
- Give alms to the poor




