Finally got someone from Motorola to come by and evaluate our radio assets in preparation for the Comai County up grade. The current time line is first quarter of 2020. So upcoming budgets will be effected.

Brief history / summary

This past year with the support of all ESD's we were able to upgrade all mobile (vehicle) radios to the new digital system currently in place. All vehicles currently have a 2500 series or the latest 7000 or 8000 series Radios. We have the minimum required number of portable (handhelds) radios for all front line vehicles in the latest 7000 to 8500 series as well and again thanks to the support of the ESD's. We have enough older 5000 series (digital capable) portables to support reserve units and additional staffing in time of need.

Here is the problem. The 2500 series mobile (vehicle mounted) radios and the 5000 series portables (handheld) order 2016 or earlier were not ordered with the trunking capability. This upgrade was not available prior to 2014 and was not included in the newer 2500 and 5000 series because the county had no idea which way they were going other than the move to digital. This upgrade was \$1500 for per radio for a radio that at the time only cost about \$3000.

In simple terms all our 2500 series mobile (vehicle mounted) radios will not function for Comal County after the radio upgrade in 2020. Additionally our spare portable (handheld) radios in the 5000 series will not function in Comal county as well. These two series radios are no longer supported by Motorola for upgrade. So they no longer be updated to support a trunking system.

We are waiting on the vendor to provide us potential trade in value of these assets. They are still good radios, but not trunking capable.

In addition to the vehicles we need 5 reserve portables (handheids) 3 for events requiring additional staffing or use when one is being serviced and 2 to replace the division chief and Battalion 5000 series portables.

Replacement summary

Mobile (vehicle) 15 APX 8500 @ \$5776 and \$200 for install total of \$5976 each. About \$89640 total for mobiles. Portable (handheld) APX 8000 @ 6664 each; total \$33320.

As always we are working on finding the best deal we can. We are still waiting on trade in value of the old ones as well.

ESD #1's Proposal to Purchase Rodeo Drive Station

- ESD #1 to pay BSBES \$1,900,000.00 cash.
 - All cash means the deal is done that year and there is no long drawn-out exchange of funds.
- BSBES pays off loan of approximately \$590,000.00.
- Distribution of remaining \$1,300,000.00 to ESDs in same calendar year see distribution section below
 - Assures plan is carried out as approved.
- ESD #1 represents all tax payers serviced by Rodeo Drive,
- Rodeo Drive was built as an EMS station.
- BSBES received grants and contributions from throughout the ESD #1's geographical area to build Rodeo Drive.
- ESD #1 is financially able to buy Rodeo Drive. (Assumes sharing of ambulance billings is terminated)

Ambulance Billings

- Ambulance billings are funds received for <u>transporting</u> a patient to the hospital. No payment for responding to calls.
- ESD #1 decided to let BSBES keep ambulance billings in 2008 which helped BSBES obtain loans to build and then expand Station #1.
- From 2008 to 2013 ambulance billings were approximately \$4,364,000.00
- At the time the 3 ESDs came together in 2014 both ESD #4 and #5 had financial problems so ESD #1 agreed to pay the largest share of the costs for BSBES's services.
- ESDs #4 and #5 are now financially sound so sharing of ambulance billings no longer necessary
- ESD #1 does not receive sales tax like ESD #4 and #5.

Proposed Sharing of Proceeds from Sale of Rodeo Drive

- Analysis shows ESD #1 taxpayers have made a significant financial investment in Station
 #1 over the last 9 years see backup chart
- Distribution to ESD #1 75%, ESD #4 13% and ESD #5 is 12%.
 - ESD #1 provided 100% of funds given to BSBES from 2008 when Rodeo Drive was built to 2013. Total contribution \$8,354,919.00.
 - Between 2014 and 2019 ESD #1 provided approximately 45% of the funds paid to BSBES.
 - Over the entire time ESD #1 paid 75% of the funds given to BSBES from 2008 to 2019

A brief history is necessary to establish the relationships between BSBES and the ESDs.

In 1978 volunteers started to provide Emergency Medical Services (EMS) to an area equivalent to the that of ESD #1 and by 1979 had received approval of 501(3) c status.

As service and costs expanded the members of the 501(3) C asked voters to approve an ESD and in 1988 ESD #1 was formed to provide EMS to the residents of western Comal County. ESD #1 has total authority to decide how emergency medical services are provided and who will provide those services. ESD #1 authorized the existing non-profit to continue to provide the services and to bill for ambulance transports in accordance with existing regulations. Also, ESD #1 began to fund BSBES, as well as donations and grants that were made directly to BEBES.

Ambulances were housed in a small station built by BSBES.

During this time fire protection was provided by Rural Fire Prevention Districts (RFPD) located in Bulverde and Spring Branch. In 2002 ESD #5 was formed to fund the Bulverde RFPD. ESD #4 was created to replace RFPD #1 in 2003.

ESD #1 and BSBES signed a new agreement in 2008 to better define responsibilities and again allow BSBES to collect ambulance billings so that they had a defined additional source of income. This allowed BSBES to borrow money to build Rodeo Drive (Station #1) and later to expand it to accommodate fire apparatus.

BEBES built Station #1 in 2008 and moved all operations to that location. At that time the station had only 2 bays for ambulances. Rodeo Dr. was expanded 2013.

In 2012 ESD #1 built Station #2 with EMS being provided from both stations.

The 3 ESDs agreed to work together in 2014 and signed an agreement with BEBES for Emergency Services (Fire and Medical). ESD #1 insisted that the services (EMS and Fire) would be provided by BSBES. Therefore, firefighters were transferred to BSBES and all equipment and facilities were shared.

The primary reason for working together was to allow the fire ESDs to sever ties with the VFDs and use the facilities of ESD #1 and BSBES. Both ESDs were experiencing financial problems so ESD #1 shouldered the greatest share the costs of funding the non-profit including sharing the ambulance billings.

ESD #1 completed Station #3 in 2015 and ESD #4 is constructing Station #4.

ESD #1 continues to shoulder the largest share of costs despite significant increases in collection of sales taxes by ESD #4 and ESD #5.
