What is a novena anyway?

Novena comes from the Latin word for "nine" and refers to nine days of focused prayer and meditation for a specific purpose. The Lourdes Novena focuses on healing and concludes on the Feast day of Our Lady of Lourdes. In early March, St. Aloysius Parish holds an annual Novena of Grace. Novenas can be prayed privately at home or can involve large assemblies with music, reflections, and blessings. If you've never participated in a novena, we encourage you to sit in on one of the communal novenas in our diocese. They only take about 45 minutes and don't require anything but your presence.
