
ST. AUGUSTINE PARISH

Regulations for Fasting and Abstinence: Catholics 14 years or older abstain from meat on all Fridays during Lent. In addition, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of abstinence (refraining from eating meat) and fasting (eating only one full meal and up to two small meals that together do not exceed the size of the large meal). Restrictions of the fast only apply to individuals between age 18 and 59.

WHAT ARE THE STATIONS OF THE CROSS?

The Stations of the Cross is a Catholic devotional begun in the 14th century. It allows us to meditate on the path Jesus walked as He made His way to Calvary. The stations actually constitute a form of pilgrimage. At each of the fourteen stations, we recall and meditate on a

specific event from Christ's last day by reciting specific prayers and offering acts of homage.

We pray the Stations of the Cross every Friday evening of Lent at 5:30. If you have never prayed the stations, feel free to simply come and observe. Then join us for a meatless soup supper in the rectory.


