Diocesan Mass Guidelines



The Catholic Diocese of Spokane has asked parishes to develop infection control protocols for their gatherings that incorporate:

- "Watching Distance" Individuals should observe physical distancing by maintaining no less than six feet between people not of their household.
- "Wearing Masks" Parishioners are required to wear face coverings whenever they are indoors for Mass, excepting the reception of Holy Communion. A mask is not required if it cannot be worn reliably or if it aggravates breathing difficulty or another health risk. Priests are instructed to wear masks during distribution of Holy Communion.
- "Washing Hands" Hand washing and the use of hand sanitizer upon entering the church / gathering space is strongly encouraged.




Eucharistic Saint of the Month St. Thomas Aquinas

Thomas Aquinas (1225 - 1274) was an Italian Dominican friar, philosopher, Catholic priest, and Doctor of the Church. He is considered one of the Catholic Church's greatest theologians. His greatest contribution to the Catholic

Church is his writings. The *Summa Theologiae*, his last and uncompleted work, deals with the whole of Catholic theology. He stopped work on it after celebrating Mass on December 6, 1273. When asked why he stopped writing, he replied, "I cannot go on All that I have written seem to me like so much straw compared to what I have seen and what has been revealed to me." His feast is celebrated January 28.


