
ST. AUGUSTINE PARISH MARCH 14, 2021 FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT

Diocesan Mass Guidelines

The Catholic Diocese of Spokane has asked parishes to develop infection control protocols for their gatherings that incorporate:

• "Watching Distance" – Individuals should observe physical distancing by maintaining no less than six feet between people not of their household.

• "Wearing Masks" — Parishioners are required to wear face coverings whenever they are indoors for Mass, excepting the reception of Holy Communion. A mask is not required if it cannot be worn reliably or if it aggravates breathing difficulty or another health risk. Priests are instructed to wear masks during distribution of Holy Communion.

• "Washing Hands" – Hand washing and the use of hand sanitizer upon entering the church / gathering space is strongly encouraged.


Kennedy Sampson was recently baptized at St. Augustine Parish. We wish the entire Sampson family all the best on this most blessed occasion.

SAFE ENVIRONMENT UPDATE

This past month, our Religious Education and Sacramental Preparation students participated in the annual Safe Environment training. These classes are required as part of the diocesan policy on child and youth protection. The students learned the importance of physical and emotional boundaries and how to respond when people try and cross those boundaries. In addition to training our youth, the diocese also requires that all adults working with children in the parish participate in annual training and undergo periodic, state-issued background checks. Eucharistic Saint of the Month St. Katharine Drexel



St. Katharine Drexel is the second American-born to be canonized a saint by the Catholic Church. Born in Philadelphia in 1858, Katharine was the second child of a prominent and wealthy banker. In 1884, while her family was

visiting the Western states, Katharine saw first-hand the troubling and poor situations of the native Americans. In 1891, Katharine made her first vows as a religious and dedicated herself to working for the American Indians and African-Americans. In 1915, she founded Xavier University in New Orleans, the first Catholic University in the U.S. for African-Americans. She is the patron saint of racial justice and philanthropists. Her feast day is March 3.




