


ST. AUGUSTINE PARISH

St. Augustine Stained-Glass St. Maria Goretti, Italian Martyr October 16, 1890 - July 6, 1902



To the immediate right as you enter the main nave of the church is the stained-glass window with significant women saints. One saint depicted in the window is St. Maria Goretti, who is often referred to as “the 20th-century St. Agnes.” Maria, a poor Italian girl, received her first Communion at the age of eleven and strove with all her strength to do better each day. Six months later, she was fatally stabbed while resisting the advances of a youth who shared the Goretti home. Before she died, she forgave him and promised to pray

for his repentance. Miracles were worked as devotion to the young martyr grew. In less than 50 years since her death, Maria Goretti was canonized a saint in the Catholic Church. Her two sisters, her brother, and her 82-year-old mother joined Pope Pius XII on the balcony of St. Peter’s Basilica at her beatification in 1947.
