
# ST. AUGUSTINE PARISH JULY 3, 2022 FOURTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

St. Augustine has recently put together a necrology which dates to 1914 when the parish was first established. A necrology is a list of people who have died who shared membership in a particular group or organization. In a necrology, we honor the lives of those who we have celebrated and laid to eternal rest. After the renovation is complete, the necrology will be placed in the sanctuary where it can be viewed by the Mass celebrant each day as he enters the sanctuary. It can be viewed by parishioners as well to remind us of those who have gone before us.

#### SANCTUARY RENOVATION

In mid-June the parish will begin an extensive modification of the sanctuary and replace the church carpet. The purpose of the modification is to simplify the floor plan making it safer to navigate and esthetically more pleasing. The new sanctuary will be expanded to include the former day chapel. Included in the design is a new altar and ambo. The altar will incorporate the marble centerpiece from the original altar. This project will not be inexpensive. The goal is to raise \$330,000, so it will take great generosity from each of us to see this project to completion. ## St. Maria Goretti St. Augustine Stained-Glass



Maria Goretti, a poor Italian girl, received her First Communion at the age of eleven and strove with all her strength to do better each day. Six months later she was fatally stabbed while resisting the advances of a youth who shared the Goretti house. Before she died she forgave him and promised to pray for his repentance. Pope Pius XII called her "the 20th century St. Agnes." St. Maria is portrayed in the stained-glass window on the north side of the nave at the back of the church.
