CATALDO CATHOLIC SCHOOL CHANGES

Bishop Daly recently announced that he is restructuring the governance model for Cataldo School. He has come to this decision after conversations with the present Board of Governors, comprised of the pastors of Sacred Heart and St. Augustine, and a priest representative of the Cathedral; Katie Rieckers, the diocesan Director of Catholic Schools; and Zack Cunningham, the principal of Cataldo School. The restructuring consists of the dissolution of the present Board of Governors which will be replaced by a parochial model. This will mean that the governance of the school will be assigned to the pastor of St. Augustine Parish.

The purpose of this change is to facilitate a more efficient line of communication between the school administration and the parish; a more immediate oversight of the school; and a greater emphasis on Catholic identity. Bishop Daly has instructed that the school will be called "Cataldo at St. Augustine."

This change allows for a moment of renewal. It provides an opportunity to reflect upon the meaning and importance of Catholic education for both our parish and our school.

I ask your prayers for St. Augustine Parish and Cataldo at St. Augustine as we prepare to embark upon a new academic year.

Religious Education: Calling all K- 6th grade students! Come learn of the many lessons we find within the walls of our church - on Baptism, the Gospels, the Mass, and more!
