A QCD is a direct transfer of funds from your IRA custodian, payable to a qualified charity (e.g. St. Augustine Parish). QCDs can be counted toward satisfying your required minimum distribution for the year, as long as certain rules are met. In addition to the benefits of giving to your charity of choice, e.g. St. Augustine Parish, a QCD excludes the amount donated from taxable income, which is unlike regular withdrawals from an IRA, keeping your taxable income lower. Contact your financial planner and tax advisor about using a QCD to tithe to the parish.
