
SAINT AUGUSTINE PARISH OCTOBER 15, 2023 TWENTY-EIGHTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Each October, the Church in the U.S. celebrates *Respect Life Month*. As Catholics, we are called to cherish, defend, and protect those who are most vulnerable, from the beginning of life to its end, and at every point in between. During October, the Church asks us to reflect more deeply on the dignity of every human life.

The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

The simplicity and tone of today's prelude reflect the mixture of despair and hope found in the Entrance antiphon: "If you, O Lord, should mark iniquities, Lord who could stand? But with you is found forgiveness, O God of Israel." Titled *Imploration*, it is from the pen of 19th-century French pedagogue, organist, and composer Thèodore Dubois (1837-1924). The *Chaconne* of French Baroque composer Louis Couperin (1626-1661) is today's postlude. It is majestic yet solemn, a fitting counterpart to the sobering theme of today's Gospel reading.
