
SAINT AUGUSTINE PARISH DECEMBER 17, 2023 GAUDETE SUNDAY

The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

Today is "Gaudete Sunday," so-called because the first word of the Entrance Antiphon: Gaudete (Rejoice!). The moods readings and prayers are decidedly different from the other Sundays in this penitential season of Advent, and the music for the prelude and the postlude are allowed to reflect that fact. The prelude consists of three fugues from Magnificat tertii toni, by German Baroque composer Johann Pachelbel (1653-1706), all using melodies set to the words from today's Responsorial Psalm: the Blessed Virgin Mary's Magnificat. The postlude is an energetic paraphrase of O Come, O Come, Emmanuel by the great American organist and composer of sacred music, Robert J. Powell (born 1932).

Religious Education – Communion Hymn Christmas Eve

The RE students, as a part of their "Catechesis Through Art," will sing a Communion motet for the 4:00 p.m. Christmas Eve Vigil Mass. The motet will be a partner song pairing the traditional carol "Away in a Manger" with the Christmas antiphon "O magnum mysterium." We look forward to hearing the group share their vocal talents with the parish this Christmas!

Year End Giving Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCD)

A QCD is a direct transfer of funds from your IRA custodian, payable to a qualified charity (like St. Augustine Parish!). QCDs can be counted toward satisfying your required minimum distribution (RMDs) for the year, as long as certain rules are met. In addition to the benefits of giving to your charity of choice, a QCD excludes the amount donated from taxable income, which is unlike regular withdrawals from an IRA, keeping your taxable income lower. Contact your financial planner and tax advisor about using a QCD to tithe to the parish.
