#### The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

Today's prelude, "Fantasia on Valet will ich dir geben" (BWV 735) was written by the great German Baroque composer Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750). Although Bach's setting was not written for Palm Sunday, it utilizes the hymn tune that we know as "All Glory, Laud, and Honor," which we will sing as our Processional Hymn today. Furthermore, the character of Bach's setting expresses the festive grandeur that begins today's liturgy. The clarity of the counterpoint is highlighted by the use of bright mixtures in the registration (see last Sunday's bulletin). In contrast, the ponderous reed stops give grandeur to the phrases of the melody, which can be heard in the lowest notes. In contrast to this festivity, the organ postlude is omitted, a somber and silent reminder of the gravitas of Jesus's passion and death, recounted in today's Mass.


