The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

Today's prelude, Schmücke dich, o liebe Seele (Adorn thyself, dear soul, with gladness...), is one of the magnificent settings in the Eighteen Great Chorale Preludes, by Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1759). The chorale upon which this piece is based touches on many of the themes in today's mass, expressed in the Entrance and Communion antiphons, the readings, and the Responsorial Psalm. It is an example of an ornamented chorale, in which the melody and accompaniment are decorated—adorned, if you will to gently and quietly express the joyful attributes of the hymn text. The postlude, by Robert J. Powell (b. 1932), reprises the great Easter hymn Jesus Christ is Risen Today. The energy of its tempo and figurations gives shape to the repeated alleluias of its text, as well as the many alleluias we sang in this Sunday's hymns and responses (and the choral music at the 11:00 Mass). Way of the Church

When in Italy last fall, I visited the Cathedral of Spoleto. It was the 825th anniversary of its construction. The cathedral is rightly recognized as one of the great architectural jewels of Umbria. On entering the church I noticed placed on the columns were descriptions, not regarding the magnificent stone structure in which I found myself, but statements from the Scriptures and liturgy expressing the deeper meaning of what Church is.

Often times the Church is described simply as an organization of religious believers or as a building where people gather for some public ritual. Such statements fall far short of the reality of Church. Such statements are tantamount to describing the altar simply as a table or the Mass as just a meal. Lost in such descriptions is the transcendent reality of what are the altar, the Mass, the Church: they speak of the relationship to the divine, to God Most Holy. My visit to the Cathedral of Spoleto helped me realize how as a parish we could benefit from such visual reminders of what Christ instituted the Church to be.

You will notice the plaques placed on the columns of the church, each with a description of the Church's spiritual nature. As one makes the Stations of the Cross as a devotion, one may decide to do likewise make the Way of the Church: Going from one to another reflecting on some spiritual aspect of the Church. Or one may sit and reflect on a single description of the Church. However one decides to practice this new devotion, may this Way of the Church help each of us to come to a deeper love and understanding of the Church instituted by Christ.


