## The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

Dom Paul Benoit, O.S.B (1893-1979) was a Benedictine monk, organist, and composer. Among his many works is today's prelude, *Le Bon Pasteur* (The Good Shepherd), written for Good Shepherd Sunday, now celebrated on this, the Fourth Sunday of Easter. The lyrical melody, played alternately with flutes and a light reed stop, invoke the pastoral nature of today's Alleluia verse, Gospel reading, and Communion antiphon. The postlude is *Toccata-Fantasia on "Kirken"* (Built on the Rock), based upon a Scandinavian hymn tune, the text of which takes as its inspiration Saint Peter's declaration in today's first reading, as well as the refrain from today's Responsorial Psalm.
