The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

Mother's Day is not a liturgical observance, but because the month of May is dedicated to our Blessed Mother, some of the preludes and postludes this month will have a Marian theme. Today's prelude will be one of those. "Prière à Notre-Dame" ("Prayer to Our Lady") was composed French by organist Léon Boëllmann (1862-1897), and is the third piece in his famous Suite Gothique. The postlude is the short but joyous "Poco Vivace," the sixth piece from Hermann Schroeder's (1904-1984) Short Preludes Intermezzos. Its ascending motives, played as fanfares using the trumpet stops, complement the Responsorial Psalm for today's celebration of The Ascension of the Lord: "God mounts His throne to shouts of joy: a blare of trumpets for the Lord."
