The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

The prelude takes that hymn tune and crafts from it a subtle and lovely meditation: *Nicea* (which is the name of the hymn tune) was composed by American composer and organist Calvin Hampton (1938-1984). As we close out the month of May, and in honor of our Blessed Mother, the postlude for today will have a Marian theme: "Chorale," from *Variations on Ave Regina Caelorum*, by Joseph Schubert (b. 1956).


