For this reason, there will be some changes to the weekday Mass schedule for July and August. *The Confession schedule and weekend Mass schedule will remain the same.* Weekday Masses will be only on Tuesdays and Thursdays at 8:00 a.m. starting in July. The church will usually be open Sunday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. Noon during the summer.

The apostle James was honored with a favored position by Jesus Christ. Not only was he one of the 12 chosen disciples of Jesus, but he was also one of three men in Christ's inner circle. The others were James' brother John, and Simon Peter. One more great distinction of the apostle James, was to be the first to die a martyr's death.

His unwavering faith and dedication made him a prominent figure in early Christianity, and his martyrdom marked a significant moment of sacrifice and commitment to the spread of the Christian faith.
