
# SAINT AUGUSTINE PARISH JULY 21, 2024 SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

For this reason, there will be some changes to the weekday Mass schedule for July and August. *The Confession schedule and weekend Mass schedule will remain the same.* Weekday Masses will be only on Tuesdays and Thursdays at 8:00 a.m. starting in July. The church will usually be open Sunday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. Noon during the summer.

The others were James' brother John, and Simon Peter. One more great distinction of the apostle James, was to be the first to die a martyr's death.

His unwavering faith and dedication made him a prominent figure in early Christianity, and his martyrdom marked a significant moment of sacrifice and commitment to the spread of the Christian faith.


