


Seminarian Formation Appeal 2024

Saint Alphonsus Liguori, Doctor of the Church Feast Day ~ August 1



Alphonsus Liguori, was an Italian Catholic bishop, spiritual writer, composer, musician, artist, poet, law-yer, scholastic philosopher, and theologian. He founded the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer, known as the Redemptorists, in November 1732.

A prolific writer, among his best known works are The Glories of Mary and The Way of the Cross, the latter still used in parishes during Lenten devotions.

He was canonized in 1839 by Pope Gregory XVI and proclaimed a Doctor of the Church by Pope Pius IX in 1871. One of the most widely read Catholic authors, he is the patron saint of confessors.
