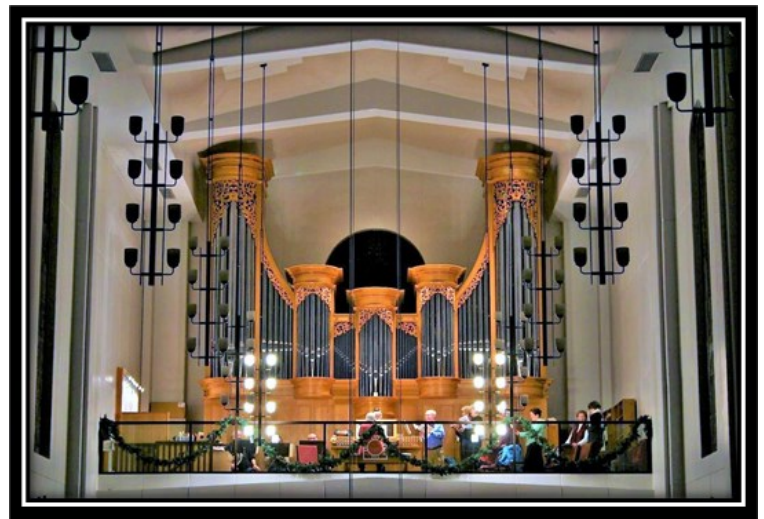


Women's Prayer Group
