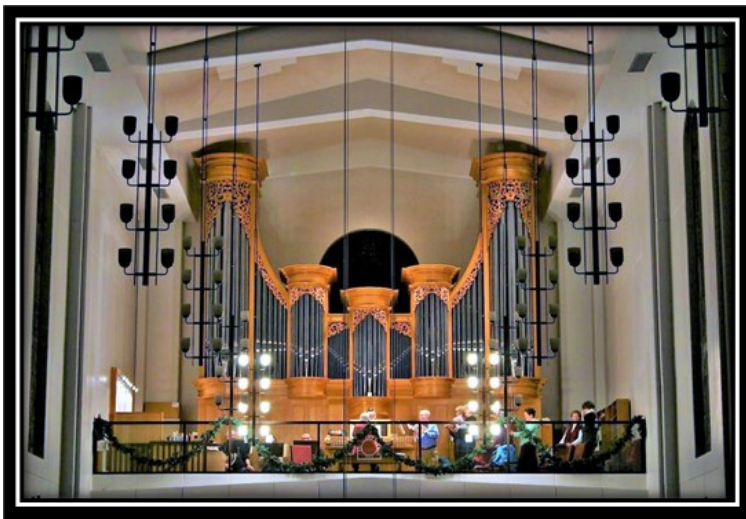

A concert of some famous and not-so-famous music, demonstrating the versatility of this instrument, will follow in the church. This event is free & open to parishioners and the public!

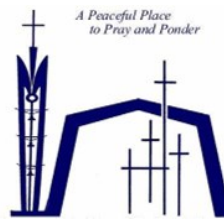
**Memorial for the Pre-Born

The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

*‘Tis so sweet to trust in Jesus, just to take Him at His Word.
Just to rest upon His promise, just to know, “Thus saith the
Lord.”*

*On Christ, the solid Rock, I stand: all other ground is sinking
sand...*

These lyrics are taken from the two American hymn tunes which form the basis for today’s prelude music: “‘Tis So Sweet to Trust in Jesus,” and “My Hope is Built on Nothing Less.” Both settings are by American composer Emma Lou Diemer (1927-2024), and the hymns complement the themes of today’s Entrance Antiphon and Responsorial Psalm (Psalm 19). The postlude is the famous transcription of Benedetto Marcello’s choral setting of Psalm 19. Marcello (1689-1739) was a prolific Italian composer during the Baroque era, and composed settings for voices and instruments of the first fifty psalms.

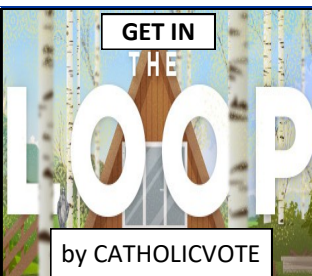


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
