#### The Organ Music in Today's Liturgy

Today's readings have an overlap with some of the readings that are used in the liturgy for the Sacrament of Matrimony. Therefore, I have selected prelude and postlude music from among organ repertoire that is often heard at weddings. The prelude is gently flowing and serene, a setting of the Welsh hymn tune "Rhosymedre" by English composer Ralph Vaughan Williams (1872-1958), and often used for preludes at weddings. The postlude is the exuberant transcription of "Trumpet Voluntary," by another English composer—John Stanley (1712-1786). Trumpet tunes, utilizing the trumpet stop on the organ in opposition to a plenum registration, are ubiquitous at weddings for both processionals and recessionals.
